Updated evidence map for the public website and Council review

A	Original Gulfport/Flock agreement or order	Initial deployment; contractual terms; original cameras; pricing; national/local sharing and location-analysis capabilities; signed by then-Chief Robert Vincent.
B	Later Gulfport/Flock agreement/order (2025 expansion)	Three additional cameras; 12-month initial term; 36-month renewal term; 30-day retention; state/nationwide lookup; historical/location-search features; signed by Chief Mary Farrand.
C	Oct. 29, 2025 Capt. Thomas Woodman “FLOCK Expansion” correspondence	Documents loss of much nationwide access, Flock investment threshold, approval of three additional cameras, intended directions of travel, and permitting still in progress.
D	Aug. 4, 2026 Gulfport City Council meeting excerpt/transcript	Chief Farrand’s public explanation of the camera count, network-access issue, retention, use, and results.
E	City of Gulfport public-records response - “No Record Found”	Shows City response to requests concerning Council/City review, legal/privacy review, authorization requirements, oversight, and related records.
F	Gulfport Police Department Written Directive 444	Official ALPR policy: legitimate law-enforcement purpose, active-investigation limitation for stored-data searches, report/CAD requirement, external sharing, 30-day retention, audit requirement, misuse consequences.
G	34-file Gulfport audit analysis / summary	4,805 logged search/lookup events; 1,690 without a recognizable case number visible in public Case#/Reason fields; training/test/demo counts; network-scope findings. Does not by itself prove improper searches.
H	34 underlying monthly Gulfport audit CSV files	Underlying source records for the audit analysis covering Nov. 2023 through Aug. 25, 2026.
I	Same-user / same-vehicle unredacted audit request or proposed audit criteria	Explains the specific repeated-targeting/misuse test that cannot be fully performed from the redacted public production.
J	Selected broad-network, training and test audit examples	Illustrative rows showing searches spanning thousands of networks and examples labeled training/test/demo.
K	SharedNetworks / Network Audit / Users-Admin / configuration records	Documents sharing, network access, user/admin configuration, and changes in accessible network scope.
L	InvestigateTV, May 18, 2026 - “Who’s watching the watchers?”	External context: Flock CCO says the city owns the data and City Council has an appropriate oversight responsibility.
M	Gulfport-specific Flock capability records	Historical sightings, time/location search, mapping, Vehicle Location Analysis, Vehicle Fingerprint, direction-of-travel and network capabilities reflected in Gulfport records.
N	The Gabber, Jan. 27, 2026 - 287(g) statement from Gulfport Police Chief	External/local context concerning Gulfport’s 287(g) MOA. Does not establish that Flock was used for immigration enforcement.

O	Gulfport Charter / City Attorney review provisions	City-governance context concerning legal review of City contracts and agreements. Use to ask whether required review occurred; do not presume failure without records.
P	Washington Post, Aug. 19, 2026 - Flock misuse investigation	External national context concerning unauthorized/misuse allegations and audit failures elsewhere; not evidence of misuse in Gulfport.
Q	Flock safeguard-change materials / Aug. 2026 coverage	External context on later safeguards such as shorter retention recommendations, required case codes, misuse detection, proactive lockouts, MFA and sharing controls.
R	Gulfport public-records fee correspondence, estimate/invoice, payment and reservation-of-rights correspondence	Documents the \$227.49 special-service estimate at \$75.83/hour for three hours of Captain-level work, the itemization dispute, payment, and unresolved reconciliation/completion issue.
S	Florida Politics, Aug. 26, 2026 - Gov. Ron DeSantis comments	Current Florida policy scrutiny; external context only.
T	U.S. Sen. Josh Hawley, Aug. 26, 2026 - Flock investigation	Federal oversight/investigation context concerning collection, retention, dissemination and safeguards.
U	Tampa Bay 28/WFTS, Aug. 26, 2026 - Pasco County termination	Nearby Florida example of officials reconsidering and terminating Flock infrastructure; external context only.

Supplemental Public-Records / Process Documents

#	Document	Use on website
1	Original City public-records request C000399-073026	Shows exactly what non-Police City offices and record categories were requested on July 30, 2026.
2	Original Police public-records request P000152-073026	Defines the Police-side scope: contracts, policy, audits, sharing/network access, expansion records, outcome summaries, and cost-v-results evaluation.
3	City initial response to C000399-073026	Contains “No Record Found” responses and referrals to Police; important for evaluating what City-level records were or were not located.
4	City follow-up / reopening request and response C000408-080626	Shows the request for clarification/completion and the Clerk’s response that it does not provide clarification/interpretation; Item 11 expressly returned “NO RECORD FOUND.”
5	Police estimate INV26-P000152-1	Shows \$227.49 estimate, three hours at \$75.83/hour, Captain-level access rationale, and “estimate” status.
6	Police fee/itemization correspondence	Documents the challenge to the initial/revised estimate, request for itemization, and preservation of objections while seeking production.
7	Payment confirmation / reservation-of-rights correspondence	Documents payment to avoid delay while preserving the request for itemization/reconciliation.
8	Gulfport Flock Public Records Case File (preserved chronology)	Working chronology of requests, responses, fees, unresolved issues and strategy. Useful as a roadmap, but underlying source documents control.
9	Vehicle-detection volume summary, July 27-Aug. 25, 2026	Shows 913,566 detections in 30 days; detections are not necessarily unique vehicles.
10	City purchase order / finance approval record	Shows the three-camera expansion purchase and later approval by Finance Director Christopher Caddell dated Dec. 3, 2025.

Website organization recommendation

Publish the Council packet and this index first, then make every underlying source record separately clickable. Keep raw CSV exports in a ZIP as well as, where practical, individually available. Clearly label external news/context sources separately from Gulfport-produced records so readers can distinguish primary evidence from outside context.

Important: This index intentionally excludes duplicate drafts, duplicate copies of the same directive/invoice, and superseded versions of the Council packet. The final Council packet and underlying source records should control if any summary wording differs.
