

# SELECTED BROAD-NETWORK / TRAINING / TEST AUDIT EXAMPLES

Representative rows from Gulfport Police Department's redacted Flock audit exports

**Important:** These are examples selected to illustrate what appears in the audit logs. They do **not** establish misuse by themselves. Large network counts show the scope recorded for a search event; they do not prove that every network returned data or that Gulfport shared its own data with every network.

## Training / test / demo activity

Across the full 4,805-row dataset, the Reason field contains **133** entries with training-related wording, **22** entries containing test/testing wording, and **4** containing demo wording. The selected rows below are examples, not the complete set.

## Interpretive limits

Training, testing, and demonstration activity can be legitimate. Likewise, a broad network search may be appropriate depending on the investigation. These examples are published so residents and decision-makers can see the actual scope and labeling present in the audit logs and ask informed questions about policy, documentation, supervision, and proportionality.
